Worship

Sundays at 10:15 AM

We are passionate about vibrant, authentic worship and hope to be a church where people leave inspired by Biblical truths and filled with excitement for Jesus! Our worship style is contemporary with a praise team and we incorporate old and new music. Our congregation is generally reserved, but we welcome expressions of praise such as raising hands or clapping.

Something that is unique about our worship is we value lay involvement for all parts of the service except the message and blessing. We look for opportunities to involve our congregation in a variety of worship experiences including prayers for the persecuted church, church choir, Children's Ministry programs and celebrating diversity through singing songs or prayers in different languages.





We average 100 people worshiping with us on a typical Sunday. During the height of the pandemic, an average of 40-50 people meet in person and 20-25 join us on Facebook. Communion is observed once a month. Sermon length is usually 30-35 minutes and the entire length of the service is approximately 75-90 minutes depending on the Sunday.



Discipleship

We are passionate about growing deeper in our walk with Jesus and each other. We hope that our discipleship inspires people to grow deeper in their knowledge of Biblical Truths, live these truths daily in their lives, and passionately love each other in gospel truths.

Sunday Worship: We believe discipleship starts in the Sunday morning worship service. We are grateful to have a new and young pastor who is committed to the mission and vision of our church and faithfully preaches the Word every Sunday. We are looking for a Director of Worship Ministries that can partner with our Senior Pastor and our volunteers to teach, admonish, disciple, and draw our people into a heart of worship.

Sunday School: Sundays 9:15-10 AM

- PreK to High school: uses Gospel Project material. PreK to 6th grade meet for a large group story and worship time and then split into age specific study groups
- Adult Sunday School: Various topics led by the Senior Pastor and Elders

Children in Worship

- PreK- 3rd grade students
- Gospel Project materials during the sermon each Sunday





Jr. Youth Program

- Developing Youth Group startup program to meet the needs of preteens and adolescents that will grow into our future Youth Group
- Meets once per month

Small Groups

- Approximately 30 people meet in people's homes on a biweekly basis
- Currently, we have 4 active small groups with the goal of adding an additional one in 2022





Being located in a University community, we are in a transient area. As a result, the demographics and numbers of our congregation may change significantly year to year due to people moving in and out of the community at the beginning and end of each academic year. This creates a unique challenge and also a unique opportunity for our congregation.





Reaching the Latinx Community

NLCC has been so fortunate to partner with a newly formed church in Coralville, Casa del Rey, who shares our facility on Sunday afternoons. They are a Spanish-speaking church who have been rapidly growing over the past several months. We look forward to our continued partnership and mutual ministry with Casa del Rey as we discuss how they might join New Life in the years to come.

Facility

Our church moved into a former commercial building located on the Coralville strip in 2017. God has been generous with us and we strive to share our facility with community and other faith based groups. We have a mortgage, but have been able to faithfully make our payments each year.

Our facility is:

- Visible: More than 20,000 cars drive on 2nd street (the Coralville strip) each day.
- Accessible: We are on a bus route and within a short walk of many community resources.
- **Flexible**: We have worship space for 250 people, offices, children's ministry and nursery area. We have a fellowship area with a capacity of 187 and use this space for coffee, treats fellowship, and discipleship after each worship service.

Community

We are in close proximity to the University of Iowa and the University of Iowa Hospitals and Clinics. This means many of our congregation live in this community for school or work through the university. The university community contributes to socioeconomic and racial diversity as well as the area being a transient community.

The lowa City Community School District serves over 14,000 students and is the 5th largest school district in the state of lowa. Their high schools rank among the best in the state, and their ACT scores sit well above the state and national average. They aim to create an exemplary school district that is acknowledged for the caliber of their graduates, the quality of their staff, and the excellence of their programs. (www.iowacityschools.org)

Heritage Christian School in North Liberty serves 175 students PreK-8th grade. Their mission is to serve Christ by partnering with parents to provide Biblically faithful, academically excellent education. 

Financials

Salary and Benefits: The salary and benefits package for our Director of Worship Ministries meets or exceeds Classis requirements, and will largely be based upon training and experience in full-time ministry settings. Health and dental insurance, housing allowance, continuing education allowance, retirement, disability and life insurance will be included. The Director of Worship Ministries receives 4 weeks of vacation including 4 Sundays and 1 additional week off for continuing education.

General Job Summary: New Life Community Church is looking for a compassionate, humble servant with the spiritual maturity and communication skills to partner with our congregation in a God-breathed vision of outreach, ministry and growth. The Director of Worship Ministries will lead, equip and inspire in such a way that the congregation grows in Christian discipleship. This position is responsible for oversight of all worship ministries including singers, musicians, Scripture readers, and A/V team and will report directly to the Senior Pastor.

Qualifications:

- Expresses through actions and words, a committed faith in Jesus Christ as Lord. Exemplifies a Christ-like lifestyle. Lives and serves out of an orthodox Biblical worldview.
- Is committed to the mission and vision of New Life Community Church
- Complies with the New Life Community Church statement of faith.
- Attends New Life Community Church regularly. Is (becomes) a member at NLCC.
- Is called by God to work for the church in a servant-hearted manner. Has a passion for worship and a
 desire to lead the congregation in experiencing God through worship. Has a passion for evangelism
 and discipleship.
- Is spiritually gifted and equipped for the roles and in areas of leadership, evangelism, administration, and music. Has the ability to play instruments including guitar and/or piano while leading worship.
- Has completed high school education. Ministry related education or a college degree preferred.
- Has gained a minimum of 2 years successful job related professional experience.
- Competent in use of current technology communication and ministry methods (e.g. Planning Center, EasyWorship)
- Maintains an open and submissive posture with leadership and peers. Leads with grace and truth.
- Possesses the interpersonal and teamwork skills necessary for working well with others.

Essential Duties/Responsibilities:

 - worship, discipleship, and outreach.
- Oversee, interact with, and develop Worship Ministry volunteers
- Manage the worship space.
- Oversee worship technology and arts.
- Fill communication and administration roles for Worship Ministries
- Continue to grow and develop personally and in context of leading the ministry.
